



For some time aircraft spotting and photography at Coventry Airport has been getting more difficult, mainly due to increased security measures. The aim of CAVeG is to make being an enthusiast at Coventry easier while at the same time assisting with the security situation and bringing trade to airport businesses.

CAVeG is working with **Warwickshire Police**, **Almat Flying Club** and **Coventry Airport** to offer an enthusiasts accreditation card for Coventry Airport which will enable holders to quickly identify themselves to the Police when around the Airport. Most importantly the card will also entitle the holders to

- privileged access to Almat Flying Club at Coventry Airport West where there are viewing facilities - indoor and outdoor (with low fence),
- access to the car park by the South Apron (Passenger Terminal)

What you need to know:-

- To obtain a CAVeG Card, fill in the form which is available from the local e-mail groups or from www.caveg.org.uk or by e-mailing david@caveg.org.uk or from Almat Flying Club. Complete the form and take it to Almat Flying Club at Coventry Airport West (between 0900 and 1800). They will take a digital photo of you, make you a CAVeG Card and charge £2 to cover material costs. This should be visibly worn while on and around the airport. To get in to the car park you will need to use the intercom at the barrier to ring Almat (Details in window of security hut). You will need to say that you are a prospective CAVeG member. While there, it helps if you tell Almat how much you appreciate their helpfulness.
- Rob Sweeney who is the Airport's Operations Director, has said he has no objection to CAVeG members with badges visible going into the largely disused car park by the South Apron (Passenger Terminal). This is how this can be done:-
"Please ask the CAVeG member to ring 02476 308601 or the mobile security on 07904639092.
Please ask them not to enter the car parks without prior notice to the airport"
- Please note details of Members will be available to Warwickshire Police who will check them against the National Police database.
- Members will receive e-mail briefing on security issues to be aware of from Warwickshire Police. Members are requested to report any suspicious activity to:-

- Members will be permitted to "sign in" guests from out of area (for whom they will be responsible) but are asked not to do this for locals who should join in their own name.
- The CAVeG Card does not give any privileges or access other than those mentioned above. Members abusing the card will have it withdrawn.
- Membership will be renewable annually.
